Discussion Items

Building Maintenance Tax Levy for Library – Informational Only

On Wednesday, July 28, 2010, the Library Board of Trustees will discuss and vote on the annual resolution authorizing an additional tax of .02% for the purposes of funding various property, building, and maintenance projects as allowed under 75 ILCS 5/3-4.

The levy request must be passed by the Village Board of Trustees as the appropriate taxing body. The additional tax requested is \$80,000, which is the amount requested in previous years. Under state law, this request must go through the public notice and petition process; if the Village does not receive petitions against the levy by 10% or more of registered voters within 30 days of publication, the Village shall be authorized to levy the tax. The Board will be presented with the resolution for a vote at the August 8, 2010 Board of Trustees meeting.

Beautification Presentation – Community Art Project

Class S1 Liquor License – Tequila Mockingbird

Ralph Villaseñor, the owner of Tequila Mockingbird 3733 Grand Blvd., has come forward with a request for a Class S1 liquor license to serve alcohol at an outside café, once approval has been granted.

If the Board approves the license, an ordinance will be placed on the August 9th Board meeting as long as the Encroachment License is granted.

Final Financial Discussion – Informational Only

Grand Boulevard Construction

The following is a summary of the proposed improvements associated with the Grand Blvd Improvements Project (Veteran's Circle — 31st Street).

Monroe Avenue (Grand Blvd — Prairie)

- Install storm sewer
- Repair or replace drainage structures and storm sewer laterals
- Abandon approximately 1,200' of 4' water main from Park to Prairie. Install new copper water services from homes on south side to existing 6" water main.
- Replace curb and gutter (both sides of street, includes median from Park to Prairie)
- Pavement widening from Park to Prairie
- Install new public sidewalk from Park to Prairie (sidewalk is located at back of curb and will have to be replaced when curb and gutter is replaced)
- Install handicap accessible sidewalk ramps at all intersections and alley returns
- Patch failed sections of pavement and resurface pavement from Grand to Maple
- Reconstruct pavement from Maple to Park
- Reconstruct south half of pavement (where storm sewer is located) and patch failed sections of pavement w/resurfacing from Park to Prairie

Grand Blvd (Veteran's Circle — 31st Street)

- Install storm sewer
- Repair or replace drainage structures and storm sewer laterals
- Replace deteriorated sections of curb and gutter (no pavement widening)
- Install handicap accessible sidewalk ramps at all intersections and alley returns
- Reconstruct intersections at Monroe, Jackson, and Garfield (install "bump-outs" in curb and gutter similar to south section at Lincoln)
- Patch failed sections of pavement and resurface pavement

Staff recommended completion of project in 2010 and to inform WCMC of decision regarding funding to ensure funding would be available.

Board consensus was to proceed with the 2012 completion schedule.

Section 5: If no petition is filed with the corporate authorities of the Village of Brookfield within thirty (30) days after publication of this resolution, requesting that the question of the adoption of this resolution be submitted to the electors of the Village of Brookfield, or if all petitions so filed are determined to be invalid and insufficient, the Village shall then be authorized to levy the tax. However, if a petition is filed with the

corporate authorities within said thirty (30) day period, which petition is signed by electors of the Village of Brookfield equal in number to 10% of the total number of registered voters in the Village of Brookfield and which asks that the question of levying such a .02% tax be submitted to the electors of the Village, then the question shall be submitted at the next applicable election, or at any special election called in accordance with law. The Village Clerk shall provide a petition form to any individual requesting one.

WHEREAS, the Village of Brookfield, like many communities across the State of Illinois, has been experiencing an exponential increase in required contributions to fund the pension of eligible municipal employees; and

WHEREAS, the actuarially determined contribution for the Village of Brookfield Firefighter Pension Fund has increased by Two Hundred Seventy-Two Thousand Four Hundred Forty-Eight Dollars (\$272,448.00) or Seventy-Five and Eighty-Two Hundredths percent (75.82%) from the 2007 tax levy to the 2009 tax levy, with the 2009 tax levy equaling approximately Twenty-Eight Thousand Five Hundred Sixty-Seven Dollars (\$28,567.00) or Thirty-Seven and Nineteen Hundredths percent (37.19%) of salary per plan member; and

WHEREAS, the actuarially determined contribution for the Village of Brookfield Police Pension Fund has increased Three Hundred Forty Eight Thousand Five Hundred Twenty Dollars (\$348,520.00) or Fifty and Thirty-Four Hundredths percent (50.34%) from the 2007 tax levy to the 2009 tax levy; the 2009 tax levy equaling approximately Thirty-Seven Thousand Three Hundred Twenty-Three Dollars (\$37,323.00) or Forty-Eight and Ninety-Five Hundredths percent (48.95%) of salary per plan member; and

WHEREAS, a combination of factors including legislatively mandated pension benefit increases, investment losses, cumulative wage increases and others have contributed to this situation; and

WHEREAS, these steadily escalating pension costs have created a fiscal crisis that is consuming an ever-increasing portion of the Village of Brookfield's municipal budget and threatens the long-term sustainability of the pension funds and the continuation of existing levels of public safety services; and

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 3 OF VILLAGE OF BROOKFIELD
CODE OF ORDINANCES TO CREATE A CLASS S1 LIQUOR LICENSE**

WHEREAS, the Village of Brookfield is authorized by the Illinois Municipal Code, 65 ILCS 5/4-1, to regulate and restrict the licensing of retail liquor establishments within the boundaries of the Village;

WHEREAS, Section 03-32 of the Village of Brookfield Code of Ordinances, as amended, provides for the issuance of a Class S1 liquor license, which is a subsidiary license, for the retail sale of alcoholic liquor in locations external to the premises located on the public right-of-way immediately adjacent to and abutting the licensed premises;

WHEREAS, the previously issued Class S1 liquor license created by Ordinance 2009-40 amending Section 03-34 of the Village of Brookfield Code of Ordinances is now terminated pursuant to Section 03-35 of the Village of Brookfield Code of Ordinances;

WHEREAS, there is an application submitted by Tequila Mockingbird, located at 3733 Grand Avenue, Brookfield, Illinois, to serve alcoholic liquor on the public right-of-way currently pending for the issuance of a Class S1 liquor license; and

WHEREAS, the corporate authorities of the Village of Brookfield deem it to be in the best interests of the Village and its residents to create one (1) Class S1 liquor license to accommodate the currently pending license application;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Brookfield as follows:

Section 1. Recitals.

The facts and statements contained in the preambles to this Ordinance are found to be true and correct and are hereby adopted as part of this Ordinance.

Section 2. Creation of a Class S1 License.

Section 03-34 entitled "Limitation on the Number of Licenses" of the Village of Brookfield Code of Ordinances, as amended, be and is hereby further amended to read as follows:

- (1) The total number of Class 1 licenses shall not exceed nine (9).
- (2) The total number of Class 2 licenses shall not exceed twelve (12).
- (3) The total number of Class 2A licenses shall not exceed one (1).
- (4) The total number of Class 2B licenses shall not exceed one (1).
- (5) The total number of Class 3 licenses shall not exceed nine (9).
- (6) The total number of Class 4 licenses shall not exceed five (5).
- (7) The total number of Class 5 licenses shall not exceed five (5).
- (8) The total number of Class 6 licenses shall not exceed three (3).
- (9) The total number of Class 7 licenses shall not exceed one (1).
- (10) The total number of Class 7A licenses shall not exceed (1).
- (11) The total number of Class 8 licenses shall not exceed fifteen (15).
- (12) The total number of Class 9 licenses shall not exceed one (1).
- (13) The total number of Class 10 licenses shall not exceed one (1).
- (14) The total number of Class 11 licenses shall not exceed two (2).
- (15) The total number of Class 11A licenses shall not exceed one (1).
- (16) The total number of Class 12 licenses shall not exceed two (2).

(17) The total number of Class S licenses shall not exceed ten (10).

(18) The total number of Class S1 licenses shall not exceed one (1).

(19) The total number of Class B licenses shall not exceed one (1).

Section 3. Effective Date.

This Ordinance shall take effect upon its passage, approval and publication in pamphlet form.

ORDINANCE NO. 2010 - 56

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 7 ENTITLED BUSINESSES, TRADES AND OCCUPATIONS OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE VILLAGE OF BROOKFIELD, COOK COUNTY, ILLINOIS, REGARDING WATER UTILITY TAX

WHEREAS, the Code of Ordinances of the Village of Brookfield, Illinois, provides for the licensing and regulation of businesses, trades and occupations; and

WHEREAS, Section 8-11-2(4) of the Illinois Municipal Code (65 ILCS 5/8-11-2(4)) authorizes the Village of Brookfield to impose a tax upon the occupation or privilege of distributing, supplying, furnishing or selling water for use within the corporate limits of the Village and not for resale; and

WHEREAS, in the opinion of a majority of the corporate authorities of the Village of Brookfield, it is advisable, necessary and in the public interest that the Village of Brookfield amend its Code of Ordinances pertaining to the regulation of businesses, trades and occupations to tax the occupation or privilege of distributing, supplying, furnishing or selling water for use within the corporate limits of the Village and not for resale;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the President and the Board of Trustees of the Village of Brookfield, Cook County, Illinois, as follows:

Section 1. Amendment of Section 07-13

Section 07-13 of Chapter 7, entitled "Businesses, Trades and Occupations", of the Code of Ordinances, Brookfield, Illinois, as amended, is hereby further amended to read as follows:

A tax is imposed on all persons engaged in the following occupations or privileges:

- (a) Persons engaged in the business of distributing, supplying, furnishing

or selling gas for use or consumption within the corporate limits of Brookfield, Illinois, and not for resale at the rate of five (5%) percent of the gross receipts there from.

(b) Persons engaged in the business of distributing, supplying, furnishing or selling electricity for use or consumption within the corporate limits of Brookfield, Illinois and not for resale at the rate of five (5%) percent of the gross receipts there from.

(c) Persons engaged in the business of distributing, supplying, furnishing, or selling water for use or consumption within the corporate limits of the Village, and not for resale, at a rate of five percent (5%) of the gross receipts therefrom. This tax is in addition to all other taxes imposed by law; provided, however, this tax shall not apply to any sales of water which are taxed pursuant to the Retailers' Occupation Tax Act.

Section 2. Severability.

If any section, subsection, sentence, clause or phrase of this Section is for any reason held to be invalid or unconstitutional by the decision of any court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining provisions of this Section.

Section 3. Conflict.

Any ordinance or portion of any ordinance in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance is repealed solely to the extent of said conflict.

Section 4. Effective Date of Ordinance.

This Ordinance shall be in effect from and after September 1, 2010, or ten (10) days from and after its passage, approval and publication in pamphlet form as provided by law, whichever is the last to occur.
