**NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING
VILLAGE OF BROOKFIELD
COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT PROGRAM**

The Village of Brookfield will hold a public hearing on Monday, November 24, 2008 at 6:15 p.m. in the Village Hall Board Room, 8820 Brookfield Avenue. The first purpose of the hearing is to present the Annual Performance Report for the following federally funded project:

Project C06-005 – ADA Village Library Improvement

The second purpose of the hearing is to identify eligible needs and seek citizen participation and input for the preparation of the Village's 2009 Cook County Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Application due in February 2009.

Eligible CDBG programs must benefit low to moderate income residents. The types of programs considered for funding by Cook County include: Housing and Residential Rehabilitation, Capital Improvements, Real Property Acquisition, Affordable Housing Opportunities, Fair Housing Activities, Clearance Activities, and Planning Activities.

Brookfield is eligible to receive a portion of the federal allocation for Cook County, and is limited to a maximum request of \$300,000.00 for up to two (2) projects in low to moderate-income areas.
